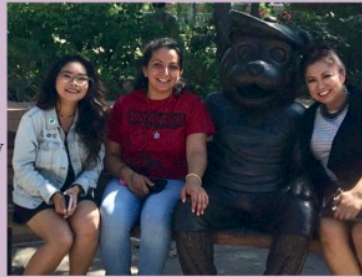
SWE vision
